HIGHLIGHTS OF SINGAPORE BOTANIC GARDENS

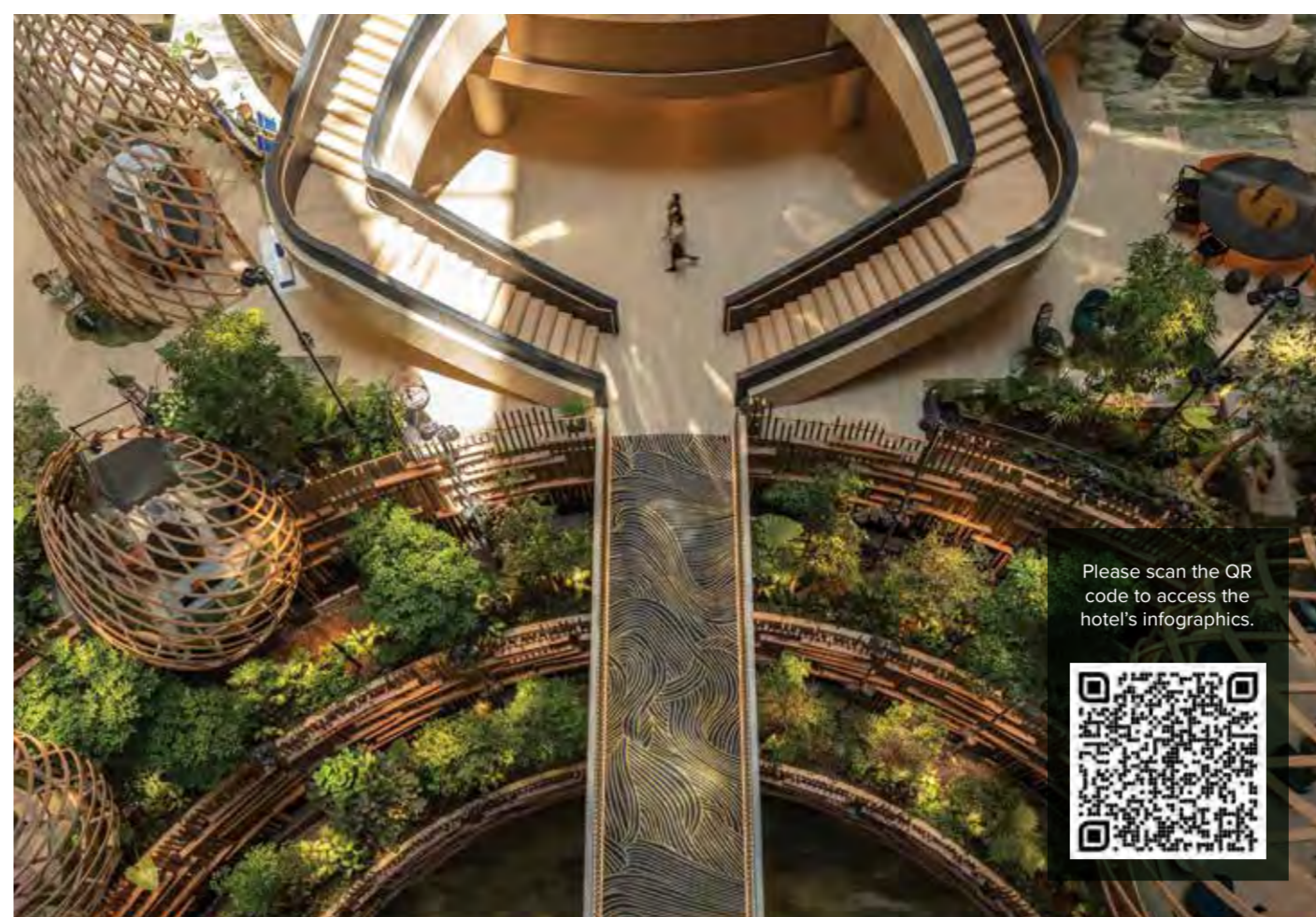
- Singapore's 1st UNESCO World Heritage Site (inscribed on 4 July 2015).
